Randy received his BS degree in Criminal Justice from San Diego State University and pursued a Masters in Public Administration from Cal State University Northridge. He also successfully completed the FBI National Academy-an 11 week course in management. Randy has earned a lifetime teaching credential and obtained six management certificates from the Peace Officer Standards in Training program. He is also an accomplished writer and has published in several periodicals.

Randy's professional career began with the El Cajon Police Department in 1970 and transitioned to the City of Ridgecrest as their Chief of Police in 1998, and promoted to City Manager in 1995. Later that year, Randy became the Police Chief of Huntington Park and retired in April of 2006. Although he is retired, Randy will continue to pursue and serve as interim manger for cities and other governmental agencies.
